What is the Trauma Stewardship Institute?

The Trauma Stewardship Institute builds on the growing body of research and practice addressing trauma exposure response. Sometimes called secondary trauma or compassion fatigue, trauma exposure response refers to the accumulation of the often debilitating changes that take place within people & organizations as a result of exposure to another's suffering.

Developed by Laura van Dernoot Lipsky, Trauma Stewardship is a holistic approach that encompasses the entirety of how we interact with others' suffering, pain, crisis and trauma.

With an emphasis on Applied Trauma Stewardship, this Institute moves beyond identifying the causes and symptoms of trauma exposure. Participants will leave with fresh insight, practical skills and time-tested strategies for becoming stewards of their response to trauma exposure and establishing a sustainable practice of Trauma Stewardship in their own lives and organizations.

Two of Institute faculty members, Laura van Dernoot Lipsky and Connie Burk, literally wrote the book on Trauma Stewardship. Participants will receive a copy of the book, ***Trauma Stewardship: An Everyday Guide for Caring for Self while Caring for Others.***

Surrounded by the serene landscapes of the beautiful Talaris Convention Center, the Institute will integrate theory with practice and transform participants' relationship to the work.
